2025-26 SCHOOL PHYSICALS

Illinois State Law requires school physical exams for all new students and students entering Kindergarten and 6th grade. Vision exams are required for all students entering Kindergarten and any transfer students in grades K-8. Dental exams are required for all students entering Kindergarten, 2nd grade, and 6th grade and all transfer students. Click HERE to access the necessary health forms.

2025-26 SPORTS PHYSICALS Any student participating in a Fall sport (girls basketball,

football, soccer, cheer) must have a Sports Physical on file by August 1st, 2025. You may drop them in the mailbox outside the main office doors anytime, and they will be collected by office staff. All students who participate in an interscholastic sports program are required to have a current sports physical on file otherwise they will not be able to practice or play.




