MANDATORY HEALTH AND SPORTS PHYSICALS

Please note health exam requirements [HERE](#). Completed documentation is required. Health or Sports physicals that do not have a completed health history and parent signature will not be accepted for compliance. The health history portion is completed by parents, not a physician. Documents can be submitted to the main office, emailed to nurse@stchristina.org, or uploaded using [THIS LINK](#).

Due prior to first practice. Failure to provide the required physical will result in exclusion from practices and games.

If you can get a copy of your medical record including immunization records, dental exams, and vision exams, you do not need to provide additional paperwork as mentioned above other than a new health physical for the incoming school year.

Failure to provide the required documentation by the deadline may result in exclusion from school.

▪ As we joyfully celebrate the 100th Anniversary of our Parish, students can continue to show their School/Parish pride by wearing their 100th Anniversary t-shirt every Friday with their regular uniform pants, skirt, or jumper. If they have gym on Fridays, they may wear the shirt with their gym pants. These special shirts will serve as a visible reminder of this milestone year (1926) and the rich history, faith, and community that have shaped our Parish for the past century. 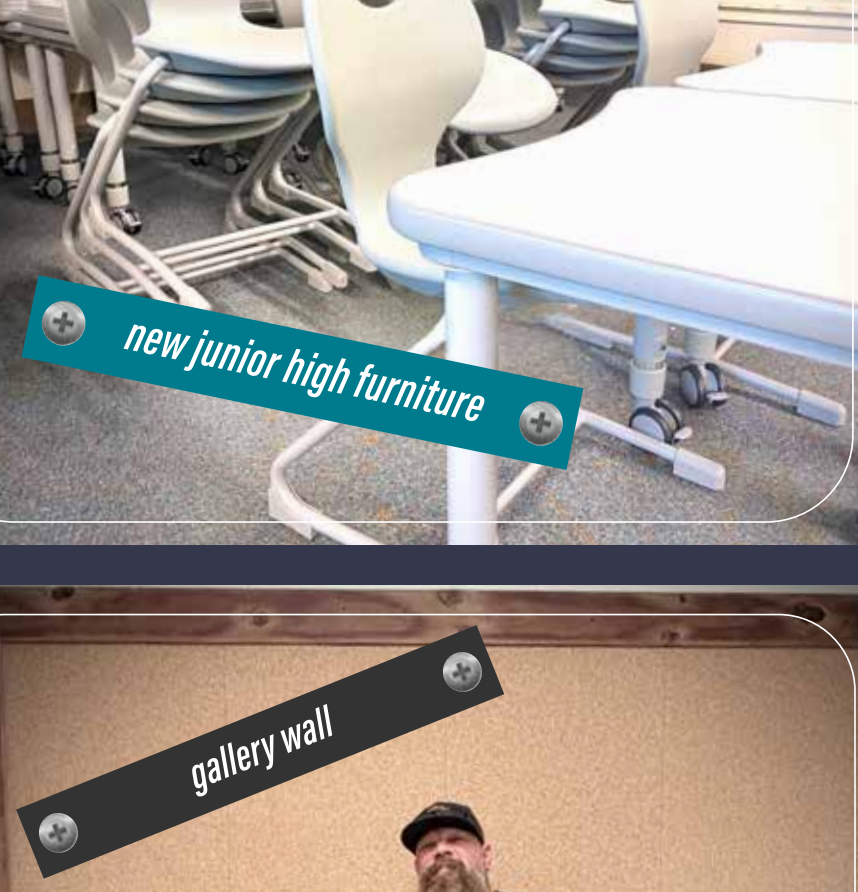
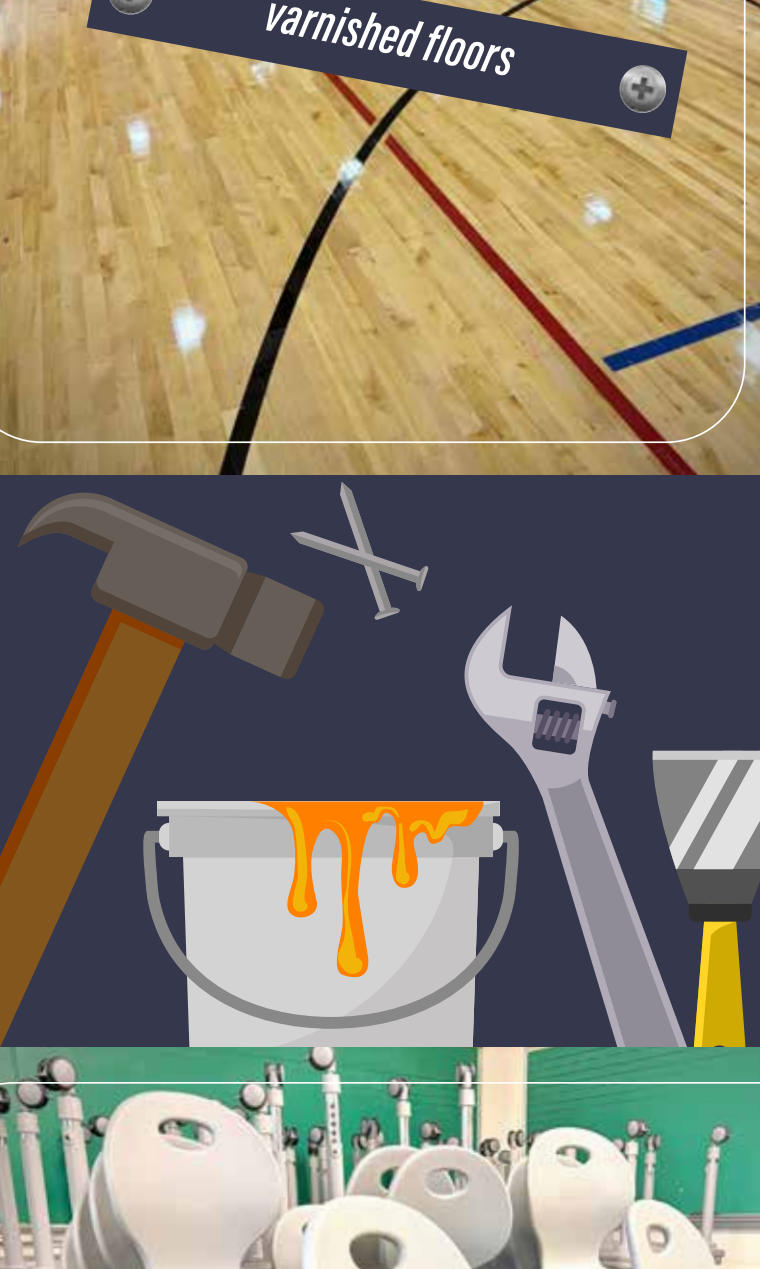
